

A New Season with Christ

While on this 90-day journey across Canada and New England we have experienced a change of Seasons. We left home in July and now as I write this article it is late September and the leaves here in Vermont are changing and letting us know with Fall temperatures that a new season is here. It is a crisp 45 degrees and the leaves on the trees surrounding our motorhome are orange, yellow and red. Wow!

Life often unfolds in seasons. Just as the earth shifts from spring to summer, or fall to winter, our spiritual lives are marked by seasons of growth, challenge, renewal, and transformation. Entering a new season is not simply about time passing; it is an invitation from God to draw closer to Jesus Christ and to deepen our relationship with Him.

The Apostle Paul reminds us in 2 Corinthians 5:17 (NIV): "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!" A new season in your walk with Christ is not about dwelling on past failures or missed opportunities but about stepping forward in the power of His Spirit. God calls you to leave behind what once weighed you down and embrace the newness of life that comes through Jesus.

In this fresh chapter, you are given an opportunity to revise and strengthen your daily walk with the Lord. Think of it as tending a garden. Old weeds must be pulled, soil refreshed, and seeds planted with care. Jesus taught in John 15:5 (NIV): "I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing." To remain in Him is to nurture your personal relationship through prayer, Scripture reading, worship, and obedience.

Sometimes, starting a new season means slowing down enough to listen. In our busyness and long road trips, it is easy to overlook the gentle voice of Christ calling us into deeper intimacy. Yet Jesus promises in Matthew 11:28–29 (NIV): "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls." A new season is not just about doing more; it is about abiding more fully in Him and letting His presence renew your spirit.

This Fall season may be the perfect time to evaluate where your heart truly rests. Are you seeking Him daily, or only when trials press in? Paul urges us in Philippians 3:13–14 (NIV): "Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus." A fresh beginning with Christ is always before you, calling you to press on and grow in maturity and faith.

God is faithful to complete the good work He has started in you. As Paul assures in Philippians 1:6 (NIV): "Being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus." No matter what your age or stage of life, you are never too far along to begin again, to refine your devotion, and to seek Him with a renewed heart.

A new season with Jesus is a sacred gift. Embrace it. Revise your priorities, draw closer to Him, and let this be a time of deeper love, stronger faith, and lasting transformation.

The Intersection

We all know what an intersection is. It's a place to make a decision.....do I go left or right? Do I choose ice cream or cake? Do I wait for the other car? Do I go to church or just sleep in today? In January of 2025, Knightsville MC began forming small groups for members to join. Leaders were trained using a book called Going Deeper. Each group chose a name, a day and time to meet and people joined various groups. These groups are still ongoing and we are looking to grow the groups and/or start new groups. The groups meet anywhere from an hour to an hour and a half each week. There are no books to study. No videos to watch. No tapes to listen to. No homework. Simply put, the groups meet to encourage each person in their own personal walk with the Lord and to find out how your week with Christ is progressing.

I have been in many small groups but one I was in several years ago with 7 other women was very life affirming for me at a time when I needed it the most. That time spent with these amazing Christian women changed the trajectory of my life. We prayed before we started and we prayed at the end. We all discovered that listening and being listened to is an extraordinary gift in our lives. We all shared a love of the Lord. We all, at times, questioned His presence in our lives during our most difficult moments. In the end, it all came down to Christ's presence in our lives. We encouraged each other each time we met, but the presence of Christ in our lives doesn't always come easy. It takes work and commitment and time. Life is difficult. But life is made much easier when you share it with close Christian friends.

Knightsville MC has a way for you to share your journey with Christ as a member of a Going Deeper small group. If you are new to Knightsville and don't know how to get connected, we can help. If you've been a member for many years, we can help. At some point we all come to the Going Deeper intersection in life where we have to decide to give more time to our relationship with Christ or to give that time to another worldly activity.

The Going Deeper small group concept here at Knightsville is a way to connect on a deeper level with your Christian friends, both new and old. You'll find faith, hope, love and friends.

We'll work hard to find a group that fits your needs. And if we can't find one, we'll form a new group! Contact me and let's get started.

Knightsville Women in Christ will resume meeting in September. We're looking for new members. Please come and join us one the times listed below.


The Morning Glory Circle will meet in the Steve Miller Conference Room at 10 am, every second Tuesday of every month. Anna Speakman is the circle leader.

Disciple 1 Fast Track Bible Study is coming this fall, beginning Wednesday, September 3rd. This class will meet in the fellowship Hall. Classes will begin at 6:00 PM and run to 7:30 PM.

This 24-week study immerses you in the Old Testament (12 weeks -2025) and the New Testament (12 weeks - 2026). This study provides a great survey of the entire Bible. It is so important to have a solid base in the Old Testament in order to develop a full understanding of the New Testament, how God prepared Israel for the Messiah, and how Jesus fulfilled the Old Testament prophecies.

We will be "walking together" in this study with our friends from Summerville Methodist Church. Marc Jacques will be leading this upcoming fall session of the Old Testament. The plan is to have Marc and Pastor Bill (morning session) to lead us in the New Testament in 2026.




