FIRST SUNDAY IN ADVENT

Words of Wisdom

November 30, 2025

We open our Advent Season with two readings from the Old Testament. Remember that these writings date back, close to 600 years, before the birth of a baby in the “Little Town of Bethlehem”.

From the book of Psalm, chapter 33, verses 20-22.

“We wait in hope for the Lord; he is our help and our shield. In him our hearts rejoice, for we trust in His holy name. May your unfailing love be with us, Lord, even as we put our hope in you.”

And now here the words from the prophet, Jeremiah.

“The days are coming, declares the Lord. “When I will fulfill the good promise, I made to the people of Israel and Judah. In those days and at that time I will make a righteous Branch sprout from David’s line; he will do what is just and right in the land. In those days Judah will be saved, and Jerusalem will live in safety. This is the name by which it will be called: The Lord Our Righteous Savior.”

Allow these scriptures to bring revelation about the promises of God to God’s people.
