Words of Wisdom - Ezekiel 36:25-27

Ezekiel paints a stunning picture of God's transforming work. He doesn't ask His people to fix themselves or try harder. Instead, He promises cleansing, renewal, and a new heart empowered by His Spirit. It's a vision of grace that reaches deep into the human soul and reshapes everything. God is always gathering people—near and far—into His presence.

Allow these words, from the Amplified Bible, to give you comfort and assurance as a child of God.

Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean; I will cleanse you from all your uncleanness and from all your idols. ²⁶ Moreover, I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you, and I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. ²⁷ I will put my Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will keep My ordinances and do them.

May God bless our discernment to His Holy Word.

Word of God - Titus 2:11-15

Today's Word of God comes to us from the Contemporary English Version, the book of Titus, chapter 2 verses 11 through 15.

Ezekiel promised a day when God would cleanse His people, give them a new heart, and empower them to walk in His ways. Titus shows us that this promise has come to life through the appearing of God's grace in Jesus Christ. What Ezekiel looked forward to, Paul declares fulfilled: God forms a people for Himself by transforming them from the inside out. Grace doesn't simply forgive – it creates a new kind of person, eager to live out God's mission in the world.

Now hear the word of the Lord.

God has shown us undeserved grace by coming to save all people. He taught us to give up our wicked ways and our worldly desires and to live decent and honest lives in this world. We are filled with hope, as we wait for the glorious return of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ. He gave himself to rescue us from everything evil and to make our hearts pure. He wanted us to be his own people and to be eager to do right. Teach these things, as you use your full authority to encourage and correct people. Make sure you earn everyone's respect.
