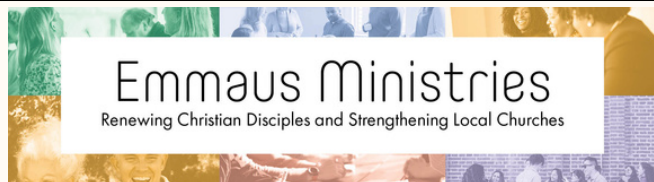

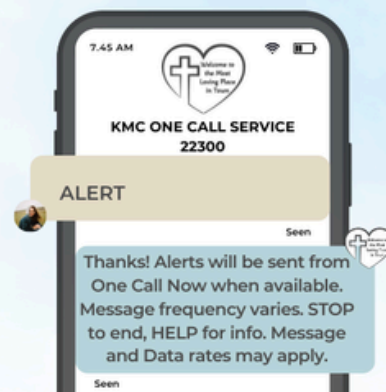

# WORDS FROM THE DIRECTOR OF MINISTERIAL SUPPORT

## You, an Evangelist?

Last month when Reverend Erik Grayson, Conference Superintendent of the South Carolina Global Methodist Church visited our church, he emphasized that the Global Methodist Church exists to make disciples of Jesus Christ and spread scriptural holiness across the globe. He reminded us that we have been entrusted with a lifesaving and transforming message which through the empowerment of the Holy Spirit we are exhorted to share with others to multiply disciples of Jesus Christ by witnessing boldly.

The word “evangelism” has been somewhat overused in our society and most people who throw the term around, don’t really have a clear idea of just what it means. Basically, to use the words that Reverend Grayson used, “we are exhorted to share with others... a lifesaving and transforming message.” That message and that process of sharing is “evangelism.”

As part of my Stephen Ministry training, I read a book titled, *Me an Evangelist? Every Christian’s Guide to Caring Evangelism*. The book is written in a format that can be used to instruct every day ordinary people, like us, to fulfill the great commission recorded in Matthew 28:18, “And Jesus came and said to them, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and of the Holy Spirit and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you.”

Over the next 4 months in this newsletter space, I will be sharing with you, from the book, 8 ways to talk about Jesus. I will share with you, the authors suggestions for 8 ways that we might share the good news of the Gospel with people we encounter, something that all of us agree, can be intimidating, There is one rule to sharing the gospel. It must always be grounded in Jesus. Plain and simple, you can’t tell the good news, without telling about Jesus. Who he was, what he did, why he did what he did, and the results of how he lived and what he did. So stay tuned, next month I will write about Jesus as a healer, and Jesus the good shepherd.

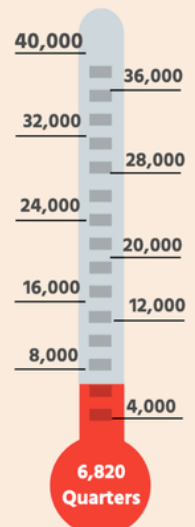

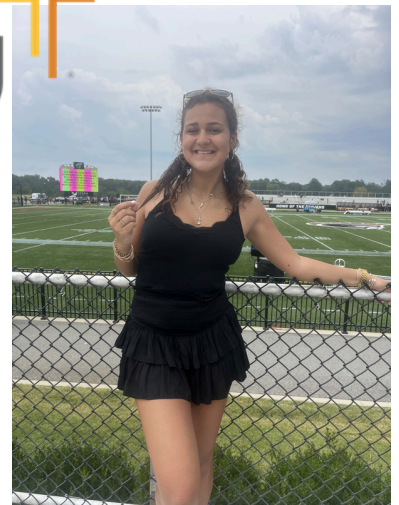

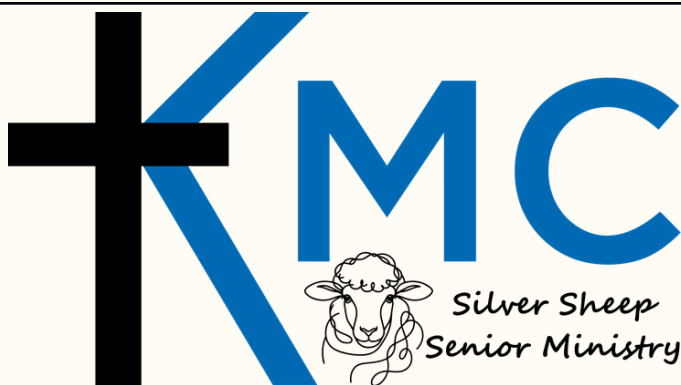
