WORDS OF ENCOURAGEMENT

Every journey with God invites us upward. Sometimes the path is gentle, and other times it rises steeply before us, calling for courage, faith, and perseverance. Our upcoming Spiritual Vitamin series, Climb Every Mountain, will guide us through some of Scripture's most powerful mountain moments—those sacred places where God meets His people, shapes their character, and prepares them for purpose.

From Moses on Sinai to Elijah on Carmel, from Abraham on Moriah to Jesus on the Mount of Transfiguration, the Bible is filled with stories of men and women who encountered God in elevated places. These weren't just physical climbs; they were spiritual ascents that demanded trust, obedience, and a willingness to follow God even when the path was uncertain.

Beginning May 24 through June 28, we will explore these mountain experiences together. Each week, we'll reflect on a different biblical figure who was called upward—sometimes to receive instruction, sometimes to wrestle with fear, sometimes to witness God's glory, and always to be transformed.

And just like them, we too are called to climb. Our mountains may look different—challenges, transitions, responsibilities, or moments of deep spiritual stretching—but they serve the same purpose. They shape us. They strengthen us. They draw us closer to the heart of God and prepare us to lead, serve, and love with greater faithfulness.

As we embark on this journey, may you be encouraged to take the next step on your own mountain. God does not call us upward without also equipping us for the climb. There is grace for every step, strength for every challenge, and purpose in every ascent.

Let's climb together—and discover what God has waiting at the top.

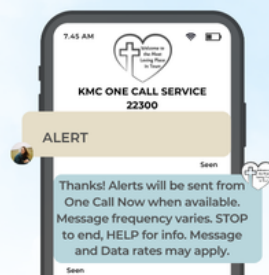

WORDS FROM THE DIRECTOR OF MINISTERIAL SUPPORT

In this space last month, I introduced you to a series that I would be sharing over the next couple of months, titled, "You, an Evangelist?". In fact, we are exhorted to take the message of the Gospel of Jesus to the world. (Matthew 28:18-20)

Jesus, not only commissioned us as evangelists, he showed us how to effectively do it. Jesus is presented as a healer in God's Word. In fact, when John the Baptist, questioned is this the one, Jesus replied, "Go and tell John what you see...the blind see, the lame walk, and the lepers are cleansed." Jesus didn't just provide physical healing though, He healed souls, mentally, emotionally and spiritually.

As a person, you are in contact at almost any given time with people who are in need of the healing power of Jesus. That healing power starts with the knowledge of what Jesus can do for them. In many cases, they don't know about the power and peace that comes from having Jesus as their Lord and Savior. You can be that conduit that introduces them to the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Spend some time, reading in Matthew, Mark, Luke and John and search out stories about Jesus the Healer, then tell those whom you encounter that are in need of healing, physical and spiritual, the stories that you have read. Evangelizing can be as easy as telling a story, and we all can do that.

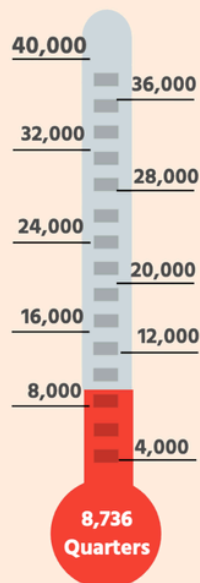
QUARTER Fundraiser

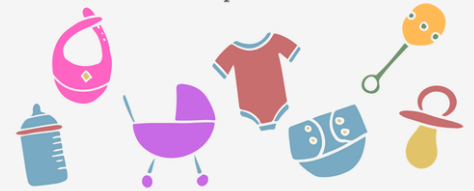

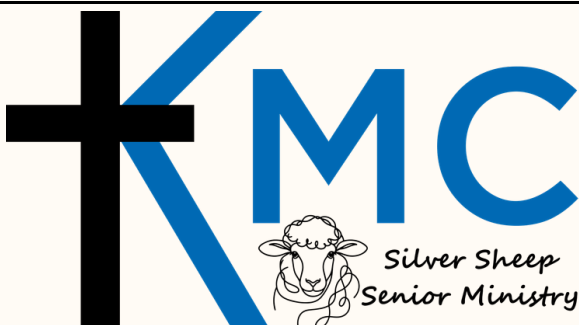

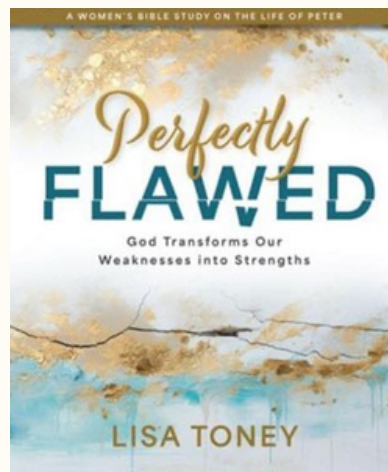
